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Dr. Zille is a young research group leader trained in Medical Neurosciences in Germany (PhD at the Charité Berlin, Prof. Dr. Ulrich Dirnagl) and the US (postdoctoral fellow at the Burke Neurological Institute of Cornell University, Prof. Dr. Rajiv R. Ratan) with an emerging record of accomplishments in preclinical stroke research. Dr. Zille started her own lab in 2017 with a focus on studying the etiology and pathophysiology of hemorrhagic and ischemic stroke and the development of therapeutic approaches for the functional recovery of the injured brain. Dr. Zille is also an expert member of the HEADS (HEmorrhagic stroke acAdemia inDuStry roundtable) international consortium that develop recommendations for preclinical and clinical research.
